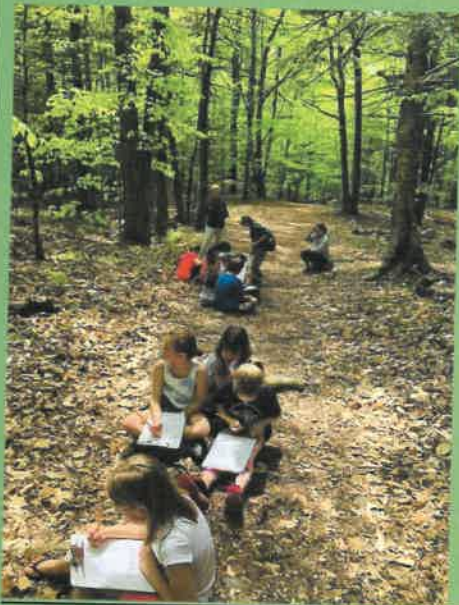

Nurse's Corner

****Per the student handbook (page 20), parents are expected to provide sunscreen. ACADIA does not supply sunscreen or bug repellent. Please mark your child's name clearly on the outside of the container. Prior to going outside, students will be given their product to apply to their skin and an opportunity to wash their hands. ****

The American Academy of Dermatology recommends applying sunscreen to protect your skin from both sunburn and skin cancers.

- Choose a sunscreen that has an SPF of 30 or higher, is water resistant, and provides broad-spectrum coverage, which means it protects you from UVA and UVB rays.
- Apply sunscreen generously before going outdoors. It takes approximately 15 minutes for your skin to absorb the sunscreen and protect you. If you wait until you are in the sun to apply the sunscreen, your skin is unprotected and can burn.
- Apply sunscreen to all bare skin. Remember your neck, face, ears, tops of your feet and legs. To protect your lips apply a lip balm with SPF of at least 15.
- Reapply sunscreen at least every two hours to remain protected, or immediately after swimming or excessively sweating.

Reminder- Please continue to check your child's head for lice weekly and notify the school with any positive findings.
